We would like to extend an invitation to you to be a judge this year at the Newport News All City Science, Engineering, and Technology Fair. All judging will take place on the scheduled date as outlined below.

The event will be held on January 29, 2022 at Woodside High School. Woodside is located at 13450 Woodside Lane

Each student participant will be assigned a specific time to do a **face-to face presentation** for the judges on Saturday morning between 8 AM and 11 AM. Judges will need to arrive by 7 AM in order to enjoy some breakfast items and meet about the events of the day. Judges will have from 8 AM to 9 AM to preview all projects without student interaction. Students will present the details of their experimental science project through the use of display boards from 9 AM - 11 AM. This format follows the basic format that has been used for many years at the regional level of competition for the Tidewater Science and Engineering Fair. All judging should be completed and paperwork with category winners turned in by 12:00 PM. An Awards Ceremony will start at 12:30 PM that day to announce the winners.

Students are working hard to prepare quality experimental science projects to present. We feel this experience will instill in them a greater appreciation for science and encourage them to pursue careers in science. Personal support and encouragement is very important to them. We really need your support in order to make this a meaningful experience for our students. Your service to the youth of this community will be greatly appreciated.
