Purpose

- To maintain relationships among former civil service and contractor employees of the LaRC and its predecessor, the Langley Memorial Aeronautical Laboratory (LMAL).
- To assist the LaRC to maintain contact with Alumni to the mutual benefit of the LaRC and the Alumni.
- To encourage and facilitate Alumni involvement in activities benefiting students from elementary school through college to increase the students' ability to succeed in all educational opportunities.
- To recognize notable contributions with enduring impacts to aerospace science.

Eligibility

- All former NASA, NACA, or Army civil service and contractor employees of LaRC, other centers, and NASA HQ who have retired or left employment in good standing.
- Current NASA or U.S. Army civil service and contractor employees of LaRC who are eligible to retire.
- The surviving spouse of an individual who qualified for membership.

Dues

- Dues are \$10 per year or \$100 for Life membership.
- First calendar year is free for new members.

LAA Benefits

Engage with other members and the Center

- Members can maintain social contacts with other Alumni.
- LAA provides a mechanism for the Center to interact with retirees.
- Members can volunteer in special Center events, such as open house and visitor tours, employee mentoring and STEM education.

Participate in monthly meetings

- Held on the second Tuesday of each month at noon in the NACA room in Building 2102.
- Members gather at 11:30 AM for lunch (bring your lunch or use the NASA cafeteria).
- Provides opportunities to socialize and interact.
- Enjoy presentations on past or ongoing NASA research and technology work, or other general topics that benefit members.
- Special meetings are held in the summer (picnic) and winter (holiday luncheon).

Enjoy social gatherings

- In lieu of regular meetings, LAA hosts a picnic in the summer and a holiday luncheon in the winter.
- LAA may also offer other social gatherings throughout the year.

Attend Colloquia and Sigma Lectures

- Presented in the LaRC Reid Center auditorium about four times per year.
- The same or similar Sigma Series lecture is delivered in the evening at the Virginia Air and Space Center in Hampton, VA.

Honors the pioneers and significant contributors to LaRC over the years. The permanent display of the honorees can be viewed in the NACA Room in Building 2102, adjacent to the cafeteria.
