LAA Badge Policy

For NASA Langley Research Center issued Activity Badges Under LAA Affiliation

Center Activity Badges may be issued to retired NASA civil service, contractor, and Army civil service employees who are members in good standing of the LAA and who require regular physical access to NASA Langley Research Center for the purpose of participating in LAA functions.

To request a new Activity Badge or to renew an Activity Badge the applicant or member agrees:

- 1. To regularly participate in LAA activities on-Center to include at least 1 LAA monthly meeting in each 6-month period.
- 2. To remain in good standing (dues paid)
- 3. That badges may not be renewed if a member becomes delinquent in dues or does not participate in LAA activities on-site on an ongoing basis.
- 4. To use the badge only for the acceptable LAA purposes outlined below and to ask a NASA host to sponsor a Visitor Badge for other prohibited purposes.

The applicant or member acknowledges that acceptable uses of the Activity Badge include physical Center access for participation in monthly meetings of the LAA and to support other LAA activities and Center functions to which the LAA has been invited. These may include education, outreach events, group tours, mentoring, Director's Holiday Social, LAA social activities in the café/NACA room/Afterburner, Colloquia Series Lectures, or activities for which NASA has invited LAA participation. The first floor of the IESB (B2102) is generally open for LAA purposes.

The member acknowledges that the Activity Badge issued under LAA affiliation is not to be used for access to NASA Langley workspaces or facilities unless part of a sanctioned LAA activity. Meetings or visits for other purposes require issuance of a Visitor Badge by a NASA sponsor.
