Proposed LAA By-law Updates

- February 2024 Board meeting discussion:
 - Review By-laws for potential editing & simplicity with the intent to move some items into an informal guidelines document
 - General Premise:
 - By-laws for the most part reflect "what we do"
 - Policies and Procedures (P&P) document is "how we do it"
- Board reviewed iterations of By-law and P&P documents => P&P focus:
 - Guidelines on how to implement our By-laws
 - LAA activities that often change: badge policy, committees
 - Document in one place in detail, procedures that LAA historically practices: communication, treasury submissions, documentation. This assists Jan transition & continuity for Board members.
- Both documents will be updated as needed to reflect LAA changes

By-laws Next Steps

- **November 20:** Sent LAA members proposed By-Law + P&P documents
- Nov 20 Dec 6: Comments received from LAA members
- **Dec 7 22:** Worked with members on proposed changes

December 23:

- Distributed to LAA members the proposed By-Law document that includes comments rec'd prior to December 6th & latest P&P document.
- This email fulfilled the By-Law requirement to provide written notice to all members about the proposed change to the Board & members two (2) weeks prior to our Annual Membership Meeting (Jan 14, 2025), when the change will be presented to members for comment.

December 24:

- Received additional comment to adjust Article 1: Name to make the distinction between Commonwealth of VA (non-stock corporation) and IRS ((501(c)(3) tax exempt) organizational registrations.
- ARTICLE I: NAME The name of this organization shall be the Langley Research Center Alumni Association, Inc., hereafter noted as the LAA. The LAA is registered in Virginia as a non-stock corporation under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and with the IRS as a 501(c)(3) tax exempt status as a non-profit organization.


- Major expenditures included the website (\$50) and the SCC fee (\$25).
