Membership

Membership Chair **Dave Hinton** has greatly improved our membership and badging process. LAA is required to vet requests for six-month activity badges, but we didn't have a policy to comply with this LaRC requirement. We increased application vetting rigor and now record attendance and screen badge requests. Paid-up members in good faith *and* who require physical access to LaRC for LAA functions may request an activity badge.

Dave also worked with Langley Security to streamline the <u>badging policy</u>. Badgeholders can now attend non-LAA events, but must be invited by a NASA employee and must be escorted if in facilities other than the IESB or Fitness Center, just like a visitor badge.

In 2024, we had a net increase of 9 annual and 12 lifetime members, totalling 117 annual and 124 lifetime members. Dues are \$10 per year (due in January) or \$100 for lifetime membership. The first year is free for new members.

Treasury

The LAA Treasurer, Ray Rhew, reports we had a strong increase in our treasury, largely due to an increase in membership, and developed a five-year budget. We started the year with \$14,110 and had \$16,459 as of December 31, 2024. Major expenditures included the website and the SCC fee. Our primary sources of income were \$1,700 in life memberships and \$440 in annual memberships. LAA also received a contribution from a member for a donation to AIAA. Thanks to **Yvonne Dellapenta** for performing the successful audit on our 2023 financial records!

Our Secretary, **Mary DiJoseph**, thoroughly documents our monthly meetings and promptly posts the <u>minutes</u> on our website.
