- **Significant Motions, Actions & Discussions from June 9, 2026, Board Meeting:**
 - DISCUSSION on whether to do **annual review of by-laws and policies/procedures**, since an extensive review/update was just completed; ACTION to Kathy to send email to members annually soliciting any desired changes after which a decision will be made on whether discussion/modifications are needed.
 - DISCUSSION on **LAA Spirit Wear** on clothing options and proposed order collection process. MOTION passed to proceed with sale in July pending completion of ACTIONS passed unanimously.
 - DISCUSSION on **Ad-Hoc Donation** committee report. MOTIONS to approve criteria as presented, to approve the 2027 and beyond timetable for deliverables and future donation decisions, and to donate \$1.5K this year to VASC for student participation in Viking event.

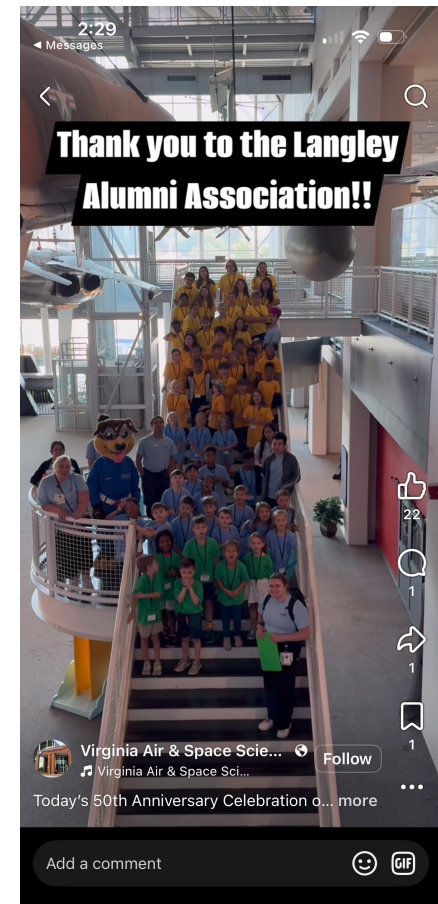
